#### 3) Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT)

The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) will take place next week at Eden.

This test is primarily written by grade 10 students, but also by students that were previously eligible to write, but have not yet been successful.

# **Testing Dates:**

**November 18–21** during **Period 1** (with possible extension into Period 2).

### What You Need to Know:

 Grade 10 & previously eligible students writing the OSSLT will complete the test on school Chromebooks.

- The test will be written over two days (Session A and Session B on consecutive days).
- The school library will be closed to students in the mornings on testing days.
- Regular morning announcements will occur later in the day to minimize disruptions.
