I have a few updates and information items for you below.

## 1) Today's Football Game at Governor Simcoe SS

- a) Gate opens at 5:15 pm. Kickoff is at 6:00.
- b) Students are not permitted to have bags/backpacks in the stands.
- c) Only students with a wristband from Eden and Simcoe are permitted into the stands unaccompanied. (Wristbands available today at lunch no cost)
- d) Any other students must be accompanied at the gate by an adult who enters and stays with them. This includes younger siblings and other younger relatives.
- e) There is a voluntary \$2 cash-only contribution at the door for all others or donation of a non-perishable food item per person.
